Johnstons of Elgin is known for the care and attention it gives its products, and its approach to sustainability is no different. In 2021, Johnstons of Elgin was proud to receive the Queen's Award for Enterprise for its work on sustainability. - Maintain overall balance sheet control
- Produce the first draft of monthly management accounts
- Cash management

- Manage the Accounts Receivable and Accounts Payable teams
- Support the Group Financial Controller with preparation of financial statements, corporation tax computation and liaising with auditors to deliver the year end

- Deputise for the Group Financial Controller when needed
